Sir,

I am to refer to the discussion on the above subject and to state that the Expert Committee of Western Regional Council examined the Project Report of the proposed Institute under the aegis of Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan, Bombay and visited the site of the Institute on 8th September, 1990. You were also present at this meeting as a Member of the Expert Committee. The Expert Committee inspected the infrastructure available at the Institute and examined the matter in all aspects in the light of the guidelines/conditions laid down by the All India Council for Technical Education to be fulfilled by the Private Technical Institutions for approval for their establishment, including the assessed technical manpower needs of the area. The Committee has recommended that the Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan be permitted to start the College of Engineering at Bombay initially with an intake of 60 for Electronics Engineering and 60 for Computer Engineering subject to review of the conditions laid down by the Expert Committee for fulfilment by the Society by May, 1991. These conditions are enclosed.

The Expert Committee also desired that the DTE/State Government may verify the real office bearers of the Society before the permission is given to the Society for starting the institution.

The recommendations of the Expert Committee are being placed before the Standing Committee of the Western Regional Council for consideration.

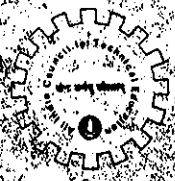

I am directed to state that on consideration of the recommendations made by the AICTE Task Force for Maharashtra State, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded conditional approval to the Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratisthan's College of Engineering, Bombay to conduct the following full time degree courses for two academic years (1993-94 and 1994-95) with annual intake shown against each:

- (1) One Professor and two Assistant Professors must be appointed by 1.1.1995 for each discipline.

- (4) A qualified Principal must be appointed as per AICTE norms and guidelines.
- (5) The Management including the Governing Body of the Institution shall be constituted and the Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
- (6) No new courses shall be started or an on-going course shall be discontinued by the institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.

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- (7) The intake in any year shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- imp* (8) Adequate funds shall be available with the institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature including endowment fund, as prescribed by the AICTE.
- imp* (9) All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
- imp* (10) Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
- imp* (11) The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- imp* (12) The institution shall not charge any capitation fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
- (13) Admissions shall be made on merits and as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- (14) The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc. shall be followed by the Institution.
- (15) Institution by virtue of the approval of the AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Government.
- (16) Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
- (17) The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
- (18) The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
- (19) Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
- (20) The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.

(21) The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.



As you are aware, All India Council for Technical Education has been mandated under the AICTE Act, 1987 to ensure maintenance of norms and standards with regard to technical education in the country. In exercise of this mandate, the Council insists on fulfillment of the minimum requirements prescribed for imparting technical education by the institution so that quality is not compromised and stakeholders are satisfied. The Council also undertakes an annual inspection of the institutions and conveys deficiencies to them for rectification.

It has been observed however that notwithstanding the Council's repeated advice to comply with minimum norms and standards, many institutions continue to be complacent about taking steps to remedy the deficiencies. Such institutions suffer from critical deficiencies of faculty and other requirements. Feedback of students with regard to quality of education imparted by such institutions has evoked grave concern. The Expert Committees, following holistic appraisal during inspections, have also pointed out severe shortcomings in key areas.

Your institution has several deficiencies, which are listed in Annexure-A for your perusal. These deficiencies have rendered the institution liable for strict punitive action. However, the Council has decided to take a lenient view and put only the course(s) which suffer from the most critical deficiency i.e. shortage of faculty in the reduced intake category. The approved course(s) along with recommended intake for the year 2005-06 in respect of **PADMABHUSHAN VASANTDADA P.P.COLLEGE OF ENGG, EASTERN EXPRESS HIGHWAY, NEAR EVERARD NAGAR, SION-CHUNNABHATTI, BOMBAY-400 022, , ,** is as under:-

The Council is committed to facilitating the institutions to come up to the expectations of the stakeholders through rectification of deficiencies. It has therefore been decided by the Council to give yet another opportunity to rectify at least the deficiency of faculty irrespective of the cadre ratio for consideration of restoration of UG course(s) in Engineering & Technology / Pharmacy / MBA and MCA. However, for restoration of intake at PG level in Engineering & Technology and Pharmacy, a minimum of one faculty with Ph.D. qualification and two with postgraduate qualifications in the respective discipline would be essential.

In case the institution is able to recruit the required faculty for individual course and intimate the Council regarding the same in the enclosed Proforma (with a copy to the concerned Regional Office) latest by 7th July, 2005, the Council would favorably consider proportionately restoring intake in course(s) where it has been reduced as soon as the appeal received by the Council.

Please note that the Council may independently verify the factual status in respect of recruitment of faculty. The institution shall be liable for strict action including action under the relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code in case false information is furnished to the Council on recruitment of faculty.

It may also be noted that relaxation in respect of rectification of deficiencies in terms of faculty is applicable only for the purpose of restoration of intake for the academic year 2005-06. All other deficiencies including appointment of faculty have to be complied with by 31/08/2005 for extension of approval for the year 2006-07.

A compliance report indicating rectification of all the deficiencies including details of faculty recruited for each course must be received by the Council latest by 31st August, 2005 to entitle your institution for extension of approval for the year 2006-07. The compliance report must be accompanied with a visiting/processing fee as prescribed by the Council in the form of a demand draft in favour of Member Secretary, AICTE payable at New Delhi. In the absence of the processing / visiting fee, the compliance report may not be entertained.

Following the compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiencies through physical inspection without any prior intimation. The institution should therefore be prepared for random inspection without any prior notice. 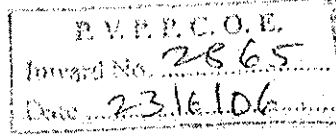

1. Whereas, the AICTE is a statutory body established by AICTE Act, 1987. The said Act provides for establishment of an All India Council for Technical Education with a view to the proper planning and co-ordinate development of the technical education system throughout the country, the promotion of qualitative improvement of such education in relation to planned quantitative growth and the regulation of proper maintenance of norms and standards in the technical education system and for matters connected therewith.

2. Whereas, Section 10 of the AICTE Act prescribes the function of the Council and mandates that it shall be the duty of the Council to take all necessary steps it may think fit for ensuring coordinated and integrated development of technical education and maintenance of standards.

3. Further, section 10(k) of the AICTE Act, empowers the AICTE to grant approval for starting new Technical Institutions and for introduction of new courses or programmes in consultation with the agencies concerned.

4. Whereas, in order to discharge its duties in accordance with the provisions contained in the AICTE Act, the AICTE has framed the Regulations for grant of approval for starting new Technical Institutions, introduction of courses or programmes of existing Technical Institutions. The AICTE has also evolved a Hand Book for approval process, which details out the procedure as well as minimum conditions which an institute must fulfill in order to seek approval for either starting new Technical Institutions or for introduction of courses/programmes as increase/variation of intake capacity of seat for courses/programmes as well as existing Technical Institute.

5. Whereas, the **Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Prathishthan's College of Engineering**, Sion-Chunabhatti, Mumbai, Maharashtra was granted approval by AICTE vide letter F. No. 740-89-2489(E)/RC/94, dated 28.06.1999 and the subsequent extension of approvals for conduct of courses subject to certain conditions, including the following:

- That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- That the Director/Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the concerned affiliated University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.

Recommendation of Standing Complaint Committee:


No original or photocopies of land records of survey number 126/1 which is claimed to be owned by the trust are produced before this committee. Survey No.126/2, 4.25 acres which is a leased land from the government for a period of 15 years, in each stretch, the clauses of the lease clearly mentions it is an open playground only, that too for public use.

The fifth and sixth floors of existing building, have no approvals from competent authorities. There is no occupancy certificates for 3rd to 6th floors of the building. There is serious shortfalls in infrastructure facility as detailed out in previous pages of this report. In view of the very serious deficiencies mentioned above and in previous pages of this report, it is recommended the **"Approval may be withdrawn"**

9. Therefore, after examining the entire matter and the facts and circumstances mentioned herein above and in terms of the provisions under Para 1 (Chapter IV) of Approval Process Handbook and the guidelines for the year 2013-14, it has been decided with the approval of the Competent authority of the Council to withdraw approval granted to the **Padmabhushan Vasantdata Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering**, Sion- Chunabhatti, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

10. This has the approval of the Competent Authority dated 26.06.2013 vide Note on page 22/N of file F. No. 740-89-248(E)/RC/94.

P.C.:

1. We intend passing a common ad-interim order as some of the material facts are common and each of the petitions require a reference to some of the facts in the other petition.

2. The petitioners at present run separate colleges one as a Polytechnic and one which offers an Engineering degree course. We will, however, for convenience, refer to the facts in Writ Petition (Lodg) No.1563 of 2013.

3. The petitioner received approval from the AICTE in the year 1991 for running an Engineering college. The institution has been in existence since then i.e. for over twenty years. Extensions were sought and obtained throughout. The last extension was granted on 19th March, 2013 for the academic year 2013-2014. Under the judgment of the Supreme Court in ***Parshwanath Charitable Trust & Ors. v. AICTE & Ors. (2013) 3 SCC 385***, the cut-off date for granting or refusing approval by AICTE is 10th April of each year. Thus, the petitioners received approval for the current academic year within

time.

4. Respondent No.1, allegedly on the basis of certain complaints, issued the petitioners, a notice dated 30th April, 2013, calling upon them to show cause why the approval granted ought not to be withdrawn / cancelled. Respondent No.1 withdrew the approval by the impugned order dated 20th June, 2013.

5. The admission process has started as a result of which this application was bound to be heard urgently. At the respondents' request, we had adjourned the hearing on the previous occasion.

6. Respondent No.1 does not deny the above facts. Nor does it deny the fact that the petitioner has, in fact, received a letter of commendation in the past. Respondent No.1, however, contends that certain deficiencies were noticed when an inspection was conducted on 18th April, 2013.

7. The petitioner also ran another college, but discontinued the same almost three years ago. The requirements, therefore, must be tested in respect of the two colleges.

8. It is contended that the Polytechnic was bound to have an open area of 1.5 acres and the Engineering college was bound to have an open area of upto 2.5 acres. The petitioner indicated that it had an area of 7.5 acres available to it.

Respondent No.1, however contends that 4.5 acres are also open to the public. Moreover, it is contended that the lease expires next year. There thus, is a shortfall of 0.80 acres.

9. In the facts of this case, we are not inclined to compel the petitioner to close down the entire institution on this ground. For twenty years, this has not been found to be a deficiency. In other words, the respondents have never considered the fact that the public is also entitled to use the playground to be a disqualifying feature. The petitioner has a lease in respect of the said property and it has, in fact, fenced the same.

10. Curiously, Respondent No.1 was not willing to make a statement that it would withdraw the recognition of every institution which had open space on a similar basis.

11. The lease agreements in the petitioner's favour contain a renewal clause as well. In any event, it is valid till the year 2014 and the permission which was granted on 19th March, 2013, is only for the academic year 2013-2014. The reliefs claimed in this petition are, in any event, only in respect of the approval which was granted for the academic year 2013-2014.

12. It was then contended that although there is a building, there is an occupation certificate only in respect of the ground and first floors, but there is no occupation certificate in respect of the upper floors. There, however, appears to be a litigation pending in respect of this issue. The petitioner contended that they are entitled to FSI of 4 being an educational institution. In fact, it is pertinent to note that the notice under section 53(1) of the Maharashtra Regional & Town Planning Act,

for demolition of the upper two floors on the ground that the same are unauthorized has been stayed by an order of the Bombay City Civil Court in LC Suit No.1773 of 2013. Considering the facts of this case and especially the fact that the petitioner was granted approval even earlier on this basis it would be unfair at this belated stage to withdraw the approval for the current academic year.

13. Respondent No.1 was able to produce only the criterion for the establishment of the new institutions. As we noted earlier, the institutions in both the petitions have been in existence for over twenty years. The criteria for the relevant period has not been produced.

14. It is not the first respondent's case that it granted the approval on 19th March, 2013, without applying its mind. Nor are there any allegations of mala fides by respondent No.1 against any of its officers in the grant of the said approval dated 19th March, 2013.

15. Lastly, it was submitted that no ad-interim orders can ever be passed in such matters irrespective of the facts and circumstances of the case in view of the judgments of the Supreme Court. It is difficult to accept this submission which is made in such absolute terms. The admission process started on 17th June, 2013, by the sale of application forms. Yesterday was the day for displaying the provisional merit list. 1st July, 2013, is the date for displaying the merit list. The rest of the procedure, including the submission of on-line option forms is from 2nd July, 2013, onwards.

16. Respondent No.1 has not filed an affidavit in reply. It merely states that the matter ought to be adjourned for a sufficient period of time to enable it to file an affidavit in reply and thereafter the matter ought to be heard finally. No interim applications, according to respondent No.1, ought to be entertained in the meantime.

17. This would lead to a most startling situation in a case where the petitioner is held to have made out a strong *prima facie* case and is ready to argue the matter finally, but the AICTE is not ready to do so

till its affidavit-in-reply is filed. If the submission is accepted, the petition would be rendered infructuous forthwith for the admission process would be over by the time the affidavit in reply is filed. We are not inclined to accept the submission that that makes no difference. In other words, according to respondent No.1, it makes no difference whether on account of its inability to file an affidavit in reply within time, the petitioner loses the entire academic year. The withdrawal incidentally is only for this academic year. On the other hand, if after the affidavit-in-reply is filed, at the admission stage it is found that the impugned order was rightly passed, this order can always be vacated. We make it clear that the petitioners shall not claim any equities on the basis of this order.

18. It is necessary, therefore, to protect the petitioners at least at this ad-interim stage. In the circumstances, the following order is passed :

(i) ad-interim order in terms of prayer (b) in Writ Petition (Lodg.)

No. 1530 of 2013 which reads as under :-

“(b) . That pending the hearing and final disposal of

the present Writ Petition, by an Order of this Hon'ble Court the operation, implementation and execution of the Order bearing No.Western/1-721415952/2013/Diploma, dated 14th June, 2013 passed by the Advisor (Approval) AICTE thereby withdrawing the approval granted to Mahonar Phalke Polytechnic college being run by the Petitioner Trust under the provisions of Regulation 11 of AICTE Regulations, 2006 may kindly be stayed.”

- (ii) ad-interim order in terms of prayers (c) and (d) in Writ Petition (Lodg.) No.1563 of 2013, which read as under :-

“(c) That pending the hearing and final disposal of the present Writ Petition, by an Order of this Hon'ble Court the operation, implementation and execution of the Order bearing No.740-89-248(E)/RC/94, dated 20th June, 2013 passed by the Advisor (Approval) AICTE thereby withdrawing the approval granted to Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil

Pratishthan's College of Engineering being run by the Petitioner Trust may kindly be stayed.

(d) That pending the hearing and final disposal of the present Writ Petition by an Order of this Hon'ble Court the Respondent No.3 Director of Technical Education, State of Maharashtra be directed to include the name of Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering in the Common Admission Process for the academic year 2013-14."

The petitioners shall not claim any equities on the basis of this ad-interim order.

Stand over to 23rd July, 2013, for admission. Parties are put to notice that the matter may be heard finally at the admission stage.

All parties are directed to act on an ordinary copy of this order, duly authenticated by the Associate of this Court.

2 The Petitioners are running separate Colleges of Engineering degree course and Polytechnic. In respect of academic year 2013-14, the Petitioners had filed Writ Petition (L) No.1530 of 2013 and Writ

Petition (L) No.1563 of 2013 against the orders dated 20 June, 2013 of withdrawal of the approval of both colleges. The Division Bench of this Court on 28 June 2013 passed the following order:

"18. It is necessary, therefore, to protect the petitioners at least at this ad-interim stage. In the circumstances, the following order is passed :

(i) ad-interim order in terms of prayer (b) in Writ Petition (Lodg.) No. 1530 of 2013 which reads as under :-

"(b) That pending the hearing and final disposal of the present Writ Petition, by an Order of this Hon'ble Court the operation, implementation and execution of the Order bearing No.Western/1-721415952/2013/Diploma, dated 14th June, 2013 passed by the Advisor (Approval) AICTE thereby withdrawing the approval granted to Mahonar Phalke Polytechnic college being run by the Petitioner Trust under the provisions of Regulation 11 of AICTE Regulations, 2006 may kindly be stayed."

(ii) ad-interim order in terms of prayers (c) and (d) in Writ Petition (Lodg.) No.1563 of 2013, which read as under :-

"(c) That pending the hearing and final disposal of the present Writ Petition, by an Order of this Hon'ble Court the operation, implementation and execution of the Order bearing No.740-89-248(E)/RC/94, dated 20th June, 2013 passed by the Advisor (Approval) AICTE thereby withdrawing the approval

granted to Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering being run by the Petitioner Trust may kindly be stayed.

The aforesaid mentioned Writ Petitions are pending.

3 On 30 April 2014 AICTE rejected the Application for extension of approval of Polytechnic College of the Petitioners for academic year 2014-15. This order was challenged by way of Writ Petition (L) No.1376 of 2014. On 12 June, 2014 this Court has passed ad-interim order in the following terms:

"(c) That pending the hearing and final disposal of the present Writ Petition, by an Order of this Hon'ble Court the operation, implementation and execution of the Order bearing No.Western/1-721415952/2013/ Diploma, dated 30th April, 2014 passed by the Advisor (Approval), AICTE thereby rejecting the proposal for extension of the

approval granted to Manohar Phalke Polytechnic college being run by the Petitioner Trust under the provisions of AICTE Regulations, 2012 may kindly be stayed.

- (d) That pending the hearing and final disposal of the present Writ Petition, by an Order of this Hon'ble Court the Respondent No.1 be directed to grant approval for the academic year 2014-15 to Manohar Phalke Polytechnic College being run by the Petitioner Trust under the provisions of AICTE Regulations, 2012 in pursuance to the application submitted by the Petitioner."

4 On 2 July 2014 AICTE passed two separate orders withdrawing the approval for the academic year 2014-15, which orders are challenged in the above Petitions. In Writ Petition (L) No.1792 of 2014 on 8 July 2014 this Court has granted ad-interim relief in the following terms:

- "b. That pending the hearing and final disposal of this petition, the execution and/or implementation of the impugned order dated 02.07.2014 passed by Respondent No.1 withdrawing affiliation of Petitioner's college namely "Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering" which is at Exhibit "AF" be stayed.

c. That pending the hearing and final disposal of this petition, the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 be directed to:

(i)

(ii) uphold (sic upload) the Petitioner's college name i.e. "Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering", Vasantdada Patil Educational Complex, Eastern Express Highway, Near Everard Nagar, Sion, Chunabhatti, Mumbai - 400 022 for the Centralize admission process (CAP) and be allowed to participate in CAP round for academic year 2014-2015 for the Engineering Courses conducted by them."

5 On the same day i.e. 8 July 2014, this Court in Writ Petition (L) No.1793 of 2014 granted ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clauses (b) and (c-ii) which read as under:

b. That pending the hearing and final disposal of this petition, the execution and/or implementation of the impugned order dated 02.07.2014 which is at Exhibit."AO", passed by the Respondent No.1 to be stayed.

c. That pending the hearing and final disposal of this petition, the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 be directed to:

(i)

(ii) uphold (sic upload) the Petitioner's college name i.e. Manohar Phalke Polytechnic College/

Institute, Vasantdada Patil Educational Complex, Eastern Express Highway, Near Everard Nagar, Sion, Chunabhatti, Mumbai - 400 022 for the centralize admission process .. (CAP) .. and be allowed to participate in CAP round for academic year 2014-2015 for the Engineering Courses conducted by them."

6 No show cause notice was served on the Petitioners before passing the impugned order of withdrawal of approval for academic year 2014-15. As a matter of fact this Court having granted ad-interim relief in Writ Petition (L) No.1376 of 2014 on 12 June 2014 in respect of Polytechnic College of the Petitioners, the proper course for the AICTE would have been to move to this Court to vacate the order dated 12 June 2014 before passing the order of withdrawal of approval dated 2 July 2014 in respect of the Polytecyhnic College. Prima facie, this amounts to overreaching the orders of this Court. In light of the above and for the reasons recorded in interim order dated 14 July 2014 in **Writ Petition No.6021 of 2014 (Mahatma Education Society's Pillai's Institute of Information Technology, Engineering, Media Studies & Research vs. All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) & Ors. and connected matters**, we are inclined to pass the following interim order:

ORDER

- (a) The Respondents, including Director of Technical Education (DTE) to allow the admission of the students as per the intake capacity of the previous years/last LOA/EOA, based on the respective Applications of the Petitioners.
- (b) The admission of the students would be provisional. The concerned students shall be intimated accordingly and the admissions would be subject to further orders and/or outcome of the Writ Petitions.
- (c) The Petitioners and/or students shall not claim any equity on the basis of this order.
- (d) The Petitioners are directed to file additional affidavits dealing with the deficiencies, if any, and the objections so raised about the deficiencies and in what manner the alleged deficiencies can be cured and what steps they propose to take to remove those deficiencies and the time frame therefor.
- (e) Additional affidavits referred to above shall be filed by the Petitioners within four weeks, failing which it may entail vacation of interim orders. The Additional affidavit-in-reply be filed by the Respondent - AICTE also.
- (f) The impugned order of AICTE shall not affect the admissions of existing students and the classes and the courses.

- (g) It is made clear that the ad-interim order continues to operate notwithstanding this interim order and the protection granted by these orders shall not extend in any case to the next academic year. The approvals for the next academic year shall be decided on its own merits.
- (h) The parties are at liberty to apply for appropriate clarification, if any.

JUDGMENT (PER ANOOP V. MOHTA, J.):-

The Petitioner a Public Trust, registered under the provisions of the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950, established in the year 1981, is running Engineering College in the name of "*Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering*".

2 In the year 1983-84, the Government of Maharashtra allotted plot of land to the Petitioner admeasuring 12930 sq. mtr. (3.20 Acres) at Sion, Chunabhatti, Mumbai 400 022 and Plot of Land admeasuring 16810 sq. mtr. (4.2 Acres) for playground. The total plot area of land is 7.4 acres. In the year 1986, the Petitioner submitted the plan for construction of building on the said plot of land and the BMC approved the same. In the year 1991, the Petitioner constructed the Building and started Engineering College, with due approval of Ministry of Human Resources, in the name of "*Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering*". During the year 1994 to 2013, Respondent No. 1 granted approval to the Petitioner College continuously every year.

3 On 2 April 2012, the National Board of Accreditation, the Apex body of AICTE, after conducting physical verification of infrastructure and facilities, has granted accreditation status for all the courses conducted by Petitioner's College for three years i.e. from 15.03.2012 to 14.03.2015.

ACADEMIC YEAR 2013-14

4 The Petitioner was running Engineering College with five courses; (1) Computer Engineering, (2) Electronics Engineering, (3) Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering, (4) Information Technology and (5) Marine Engineering and was also running (6) Diploma College, (7) Management College (Branches/College at Sr. No. 5, 6 and 7 are now closed down). On 19 March 2013, Respondent No. 1 granted approval for Academic Year 2013-14. There was a complaint by Citizen Forum against the Petitioner college to Respondent No. 1 and on the basis of the said complaint, Respondent No. 1 started taking action against the Petitioner College. On 18 April 2013, Respondent No. 1 appointed Expert Committee for Inspection on the basis of complaint. On 30 April 2013, Respondent No.1 issued a show cause notice on the basis of report of Expert Committee as to

why their affiliation should not be withdrawn. The Petitioner filed a reply to show cause notice and also appeared before the Committee and submitted all the relevant documents. On 20 June 2013, Respondent No. 1 withdrawn the affiliation on the grounds of deficiency shown by the Expert Committee in their Report. On 28 June 2013, the Petitioner filed a Writ Petition bearing No. 1733 of 2013 challenging the order of withdrawal dated 20 June 2013 and this Court, (Coram:- Mr. S.J.Vazifdar and Mr. M.S.Sonak JJ.), has granted stay to impugned order dated 20 June 2013. The said Petition is pending for disposal.

ACADEMIC YEAR 2014-15

5 The Petitioner closed the Marine Engineering Course and Management College and running only Engineering and Diploma College. On 23 May 2014, the Petitioner applied for grant of extension of approval for academic year 2014-15 through online. The Petitioner received no Deficiency Report through online. Respondent No. 1 not granted extension of approval along with other college having no deficiency report as per the scheduled program. On 26 June 2014, Respondent No. 1 appointed Expert Visit Committee (EVC)

for inspection and they submitted the report recommending not to grant EOA. On 2 July 2014, Respondent No. 1 refused to grant EOA and withdrawn the affiliation of the college on the basis of recommendation of Standing Complaint Committee. On 8 July 2014, the Petitioner challenged order dated 2 July 2014 by filing Writ Petition No. 2532 of 2014 and this Court has granted ad-interim relief in the same. On 14 July 2014, the Division Bench has granted interim relief in Writ Petition No. 2532 of 2014. The said Petition is pending for final disposal.

ACADEMIC YEAR 2015-16

6 The Petitioner applied for closure progressive of Diploma Course and Respondent No. 1 has granted permission on 8 April 2015. Subsequently, Respondent No. 1 passed order on 15 May 2015 to close the Diploma College and thus the Petitioner is running only one college. The Petitioner is having 3.2 acres land for college building and 4.2 acres land for playground. The Petitioner also having sufficient infrastructure for Degree College. Respondent No. 1 has refused to grant EOA for the academic year 2015-16 on the ground, for want of Occupation Certificate, though the Standing Complaint

Committee granted time to submit Occupation Certificate and the workshop is in temporary shed. The Petitioner after complete closure of Diploma, shifted workshop into building. Therefore, the said deficiency is also removed.

7 On 27 February 2015, the Petitioner submitted the application for seeking Extension of Approval for the academic year 2014-15 to Respondent No. 1 and they received "No Deficiency Report". On 27 March 2015, Respondent No. 1 appointed EVC to verify the details mentioned in the EOA application. EVC visited the college and submit the report to Respondent No. 1 showing certain deficiencies in area of the laboratories, faculties and Occupancy Certificate etc.. EVC recommended not to grant EOA. On 7 April 2014, Respondent No. 1 issued order of rejection, informing that they refused to grant EOA on any one of the 17 grounds, without hearing the Petitioner. On 13 April 2015, EVC at the time of visit, orally informed about deficiency in the area of laboratories and classrooms. The Petitioner therefore, immediately gave letter to Respondent No. 1 explaining the status of the Institution. Respondent No. 1, placed the matter for hearing before Standing Complaint Committee. On 22

April 2015, hearing took place before the Standing Complaint Committee at New Delhi. The Petitioner filed a detail reply pointing out that all the deficiencies except Occupation Certificate, have been complied with. The Petitioner gave application to the Standing Complaint Committee to give four months time to submit Occupancy Certificate, which they have granted. From the impugned order it is clear that, Standing Complaint Committee was satisfied about compliance of deficiency and also granted time to obtain Occupancy Certificate, but inspite of that the SAC recommended to put Petitioner college in 'No Admission Category' for the academic year 2015-16. The SAC has not given any specific reason as to why the Petitioner College be put into the "No Admission" category. On 26 April 2015, Respondent No. 1 placed the report of the Standing Complaint Committee for approval before the competent authority and the competent authority without hearing the Petitioner approved proposal submitted by SAC. On 30 April 2015, the Advisor-II (Approval) of Respondent No. 1, communicated the decision of the competent authority by letter dated 30 April 2014, informing the Petitioner that, they have refused to grant Extension of Approval to Petitioner's College. This order was also issued by advisor II (Approval) without

hearing the Petitioner. On 1 May 2015, Respondent No. 1, by email informed the Petitioner that they have rejected the intake capacity of the Petitioner College and enclosed the copy of order dated 30 April 2015, refusing to grant EOA for the academic year 2015-16. Respondent No. 1 had withdrawn the affiliation of the Petitioner college in the academic year 2013-14 and the same is continued in the year 2014-15. However, both the orders passed by Respondent No. 1 are stayed by this Court. Respondent No. 1 restored the intake of the college, it means that they have withdrawn the order of withdrawing affiliation of the entire college and only refused to grant EOA for the year 2015-16. On 1 May 2015, the Petitioner applied to Respondent No.1, requesting them to supply the copy of the Report of Standing Complaint Committee. On 2 May 2015, the Petitioner filed a Petition and challenged impugned order dated 30 April 2015.

8 On 15 May 2015, the Petitioner moved before the Vacation Court for seeking interim relief and the Vacation Court observed that *“apart from the deficiency concerning occupancy certificate, which the Petitioner Institute has been allowed to comply within 4 months period, there are deficiencies even concerning the faculties. The impugned order*

of AICTE refers to the failure of the Petitioner to submit Selection Committee Proceeding and Paper Notification about the methodology adopted in recruiting staff. So also the impugned order refers to non furnishing bank salary statement and acquaintance register of existing staff of the petitioner.” The Vacation Court further observed that, “subject to Petitioner complying with the requirement of AICTE referred above and AICTE accepting such compliance, the Petitioner Institute is allowed to participate in the centralize admission process. The Petitioner shall comply with the required referred above within a week from today. AICTE shall consider the same within a period of one week after such compliance. Subject to compliance being found satisfactory the respondents are directed to upload the Petitioners name for centralize admission process and allow the Petitioner in CAP round admission procedure for academic year 2015-16”. On 19 May 2015, as per the order of the Vacation Court, the Petitioner submitted all the documents regarding recruitment of faculty before Respondent No. 1. Respondent No. 1 passed the order for complete closure of Diploma College of the Petitioner on 15 May 2015, which received by the Petitioner on 19 May 2015. The Petitioner has not filed any appeal challenging the order passed by Respondent No. 1 refusing to grant

EOA before Standing Appellate Committee, however they only submitted the documents before Respondent No. 1 as per the directions of the vacation Court. Respondent No. 1 however, fixed the hearing before Standing Appellate Committee on 29 May 2015. On 29 May 2015, there was a hearing before Standing Appellate Committee, at New Delhi and the Standing Appellate Committee, satisfied about the compliance of the deficiency in faculty. However, new grounds were added by the Standing Appellate Committee stating that there is a deficiency in maintaining Cadre Ratio, and therefore, refused to grant EOA. This is clearly in violation of the order passed by Vacation Court, as the scope of the enquiry was limited to only faculties. On 9 June 2015, the Advisor Approval of Respondent No. 1, passed the order on the basis of Report of Standing Appellate Committee, refusing to grant EOA though the Petitioner complied with the deficiency of faculty. There is a deficiency only in Cadre Ratio and area of classroom to the extent of only 5%. The Standing Complaint Committee has granted time to submit Occupancy Certificate. The detail chart of deficiencies pointed out by EVC, Standing Complaint Committee and Standing Appellate Committee is annexed to the additional affidavit filed on 3 July 2015. The Petitioner is challenging

Impugned orders passed by Respondent No. 1 dated 30 April 2015 and 9 June 2015, by way of present Petition.

9 The Petitioner, therefore, filed the present Petition and prayed as under:-

"a) That this Hon'ble Court be pleased to issue appropriate writ and/or direction under article 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India calling for record and proceeding of the impugned order dated 30.04.2015 and report of the Standing Appellate Committee dated 29.05.2015 and the impugned order dated 09.06.2015 refusing to grant EOA to the Petitioner's College namely Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering for the year 2015-2016 and after looking into legality and propriety of the impugned order, the same be quashed and set aside and direct the Respondent no.1 to grant EOA for the year 2015-2016 and thereafter.

b) That pending the hearing and final disposal of this petition, the execution and/or implementation of the impugned order dated 30.04.2015 and report of the Standing Appellate Committee dated 29.05.2015 and the impugned order dated 09.06.2015 passed by Respondent No. 1 refusing to grant extension of approval to Petitioner's college namely "Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering" for the year 2015-16 which is at EXHIBIT. "R" be stayed.

c) That pending the hearing and final disposal of this petition, the Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 be directed to:

(i) grant extension to approval to the Petitioner's College i.e. Padambhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering for the year 2015-2016 as per their application.

(ii) uphold the Petitioner's college name i.e. "Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering", Vasantdada Patil Educational Complex, Eastern Express Highway, Near Everard Nagar, Sion Chunabhatti, Mumbai - 400 022 for the Centralise admission process (CAP) and be allowed to participate in CAP round for academic year 2015-16 for the Engineering Courses conducted by them."

10 Both the parties have referred and relied on the Supreme Court and High Court Judgments, as noted noted in Writ Petition No. 4586 of 2015.

11 The learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Petitioner has pointed out, referring to the comparative chart of deficiencies for the year 2015-16 with the deficiencies in the year 2014-15. Deficiencies in the year 2014-15 were not the major deficiencies of this year, except deficiencies of 5% in the area of classrooms. Occupation Certificate deficiency, in concern now the Standing Complaint Committee in view of the earlier orders passed by this Court (vacation Judge) granted time to submit the Occupation

Certificate. The time is not yet expired therefore, that deficiency is also not deficiency for this year. The cadre ratio deficiency was the deficiency of the last year and this year also. It is pointed out that in view of chapter VI of norms and requirement, Rule No.1.8, cadre ratio shall be maintained. The detailed explanation about faculty and the ratio has been provided in the affidavit in rejoinder of the Petitioner, which reads thus:-

“13. The Petitioner Institute submits that there is no requirement of the cadre ratio. The AICTE's Hand Book for the year 2015-2016 in clause 5 of chp. IV provides for the faculty Student ratio. The AICTE's Hand Book stipulates that ordinarily the cadre ratio be maintained. Without prejudice to the said arguments the Petitioner Institute has with its consistent efforts been able to appoint the required faculty. As regards the cadre ratio the Petitioner Institute submits that continuous and sincere efforts are being made to ensure that the same is ordinarily maintained by appointing faculty as per the AICTE norms and approval process hand book.”

Role of the State Government and the DTE and the DTE Report:-

12 The DTE has no role to play in the procedure so prescribed, when the Petitioner and/or such institution seeks extension of approval. The DTE officers only facilitate the Centralize Admission Process and is bound to include the AICTE in the CAP round now, as per the Maharashtra Ordinance No. VII of 2015 [The

Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Ordinance, 2015], dated 12 May 2015. Therefore, the role of the State and the DTE, is restricted. The handbook so read nowhere provides such role of DTE, except the initial stages so recorded in the schedule by the Supreme Court in Parshvanath.

13 The submission of the Petitioner that the impugned order violates the basic principle of natural justice and the documents, reports, recommendation not furnished to the Petitioner's institution and no hearing given to the Petitioner institution, at the relevant time, though subsequently it was given in view of the Judgment/order passed by this Court (Vacation Judge). The hearing not given, at the appropriate time and stage before passing the order on 30 April 2015 still remains, are also decided. The person, who heard the Petitioner, did not decide, which specifically not observed the last year order and judgment and the same is again reinforced and maintained. There is force in the submission that the time lines, as laid down by the Supreme Court in Parshvanath (supra) have not been followed by the AICTE. The Petitioner institution's right of Appeal was denied due to

the delay on the part of the AICTE, in passing order on 30 April 2015 at the relevant time, though now granted after filing of the Writ Petition on 5 May 2015. The submission on the point of discrimination and decision based upon the pre-determined mind and bias attitude are also dealt with in favour of the Petitioner. The permission is not granted and/or denied to such institution. In the background, the case of prejudice and injustice is definitely made out. The AICTE- Respondents again followed and proceeded on the earlier complaint made in the year 2014. The Public Interest Litigation, as well as, the Criminal Appeals against the AICTE are also pending referring to the various issues and mismanagement and challenging the whole affairs of the AICTE. The selection of the Petitioner along with other 11 and taking action against them, inspite of the earlier Judgments/orders passed by this Court and by overlooking the same and even by not challenging the same, taken such unsustainable action based on the consideration other than law. "No admission category" for the year 2015-16, definitely caused injustice and hardship, therefore, affects not only to the institution, but the students of the area also.

14 In view of the discussion made in the foregoing paragraphs and taking overall view of the matter for the reasons in detail already recorded in connected Writ Petition i.e. Saraswati Education Society's Saraswati College of Engineering Vs. All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Writ Petition No. 4586 of 2015, decided on 14 August 2015, we are inclined to allow the Petition and pass the following order:-

ORDER

- a) Writ Petition is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a).
- b) Interim order passed by this Court on 23 June 2015, is confirmed.
- c) The Respondents are directed to consider the representation/case of the Petitioners, specifically on the issue of cadre and faculty ratio and related aspects by giving opportunity of hearing to Petitioner and pass the reasoned order, at the earliest.
- d) The Respondent-University is directed that in order to avoid the delay in appointments of teaching

faculty in the institution like the Petitioners, the proposals received for approval of draft advertisement, roaster, nomination of the subject experts, nomination of nominee of the Vice Chancellor and approval of the candidates selected through duly constituted Selection Committee, such proposals be decided in expeditious and time bound manner so as to avoid deficiencies in respect of the same being shown by AICTE in the proposals of such institution for extension of approval.

- e) The Petitioner is directed to take necessary steps to remove the deficiencies, even if any, as early as possible.
- f) Writ Petition is accordingly allowed.
- g) Rule made absolute accordingly.
- h) There shall be no order as to costs.

4. Considered the prayer for interim relief. According to the learned senior counsel for the petitioner, the Appellate Authority has rejected the petitioner's appeal on the ground that the petitioner is not having 'Occupation Certificate'. He submits that the petitioner institution is running since the year 1991 and in the matter of grant of extension of approval, there is no requirement of submission of Occupation Certificate and only sanctioned plan is required to be submitted. He submits that as per Chapter I, only for approval of new courses the

Occupation Certificate is required. Even otherwise, according to him as the matter for grant of Occupation Certificate is pending for consideration before the BMC and there is no dispute as to the construction part of the petitioner's building, but the dispute between BMC and the petitioner is relating to the demand raised by the BMC to the extent of about Rs.4,95,00,000/- for which the petitioner is not liable. He submits that challenging such huge demand the petitioner had filed a writ petition before this Court which is numbered as W.P. No. 2841 of 2015 which is likely to be heard on 20.6.2016. He submits that the petitioner is ready to give an undertaking to the effect that in case the petitioner's petition is dismissed, the petitioner shall deposit the amount as claimed by the Planning Authority.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent, on the other hand, objected the prayer for grant of interim relief on the ground that in the absence of Occupation Certificate, the Appellate Authority has rightly refused to grant extension of approval as in the absence of Occupation Certificate, it would be hazardous for the students to study in the college. She submits that a mishap had occurred in Chennai college and as such the requirement of Occupation Certificate cannot be waived.

6. Replying to the aforesaid submissions, the learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that so far as contention of the respondent that the building is not habitable, is not correct as the

Occupation Certificate has not been refused or withheld on the ground that the building is not in a habitable condition but it has been withheld on the ground of non payment of demand of cost of retention wall, which according to the petitioner, has not to be borne by the petitioner alone.

7. Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and having gone through the impugned order, prima facie, we are of the view that the order of the Appellate Authority is not a reasoned order and it does not deal with various grounds raised in the memo of appeal as also the ground as to whether for grant of extension of approval, Occupation Certificate is required. Keeping in view the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties, we are inclined to grant interim relief prayed by the petitioner in terms of prayer clause 67(b).

8. In view of the above, there shall be interim relief in terms of prayer clause 67(b), subject to the petitioner to make it clear to the students that the writ petition is pending before this Court against refusal of extension of approval by the Appellate Authority. The Petitioner shall also make it clear on its portal this aspect of the matter. The same shall also be duly notified on the portal by the State and the petitioner to submit an undertaking in this Court within a week to the effect that in case Writ Petition No.2841 of 2015 is dismissed, the petitioner shall deposit the amount claimed by the

Planning Authority for issuance of occupation certificate within two weeks. It is made clear that the admissions as may be made by the petitioner would be subject to the outcome of the petition and the students will not be entitled to claim any equity on the basis of this interim order. The Petitioner shall make it clear to every student. Matter be listed for final hearing after eight weeks.
