

- (iii) These seats shall be filled in by the institution on the basis of Inter-Se-Merit of candidates as given in section 8 of this brochure. (iv)Candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria for Foreign Nationals/PIOs/Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries/Child or Ward of NRI shall send their applications to the designated centres notified by the Competent Authority for this purpose.
