Post Event Summary:

Team ITSA of Information Technology department of VPPCOE & VA organized an event named Techgyanathon. There event consisted of 4 competitions. The competitions were: Project competition, Coding competition, Web development competition and Tech Hunt. The competitions were held in the labs of VPPCOE. The timing of the event was from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm. The event started off with light lamping ceremony and Saraswati Vandana. The event was followed by the felicitation of dignitaries on the dais.

• Project competition:

Project competition was held in lab 107 and 108. In this competition, total 16 groups each consisting of 4 students had participated. In this competition, students were supposed to present the projects to the judges and answer their questions. This competition was an amazing opportunity for students to showcase their skills.

Coding competition:

participated. In this competition, students were given a problem statement to solve. Coding competition was a great opportunity for students to improve their coding skills.
