- How to perform a time bound task. To know what leadership qualities one should have to become successful.

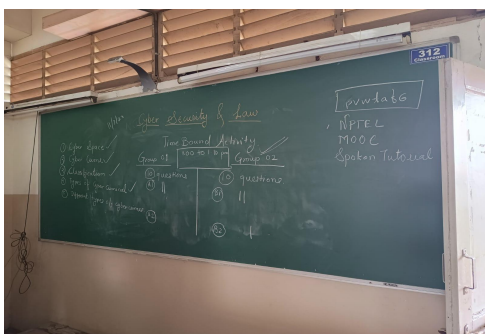


Outcome-
