The Parent Teacher Interaction meeting was conducted as per the following schedule:


1. Parent teacher gathering was started by tea and biscuits.

attendance, terminal examination marks and overall discipline in the campus.


8. The PTM came to an end with the conclusion that the progress and development of the students depend on the joint efforts of parents and teachers.

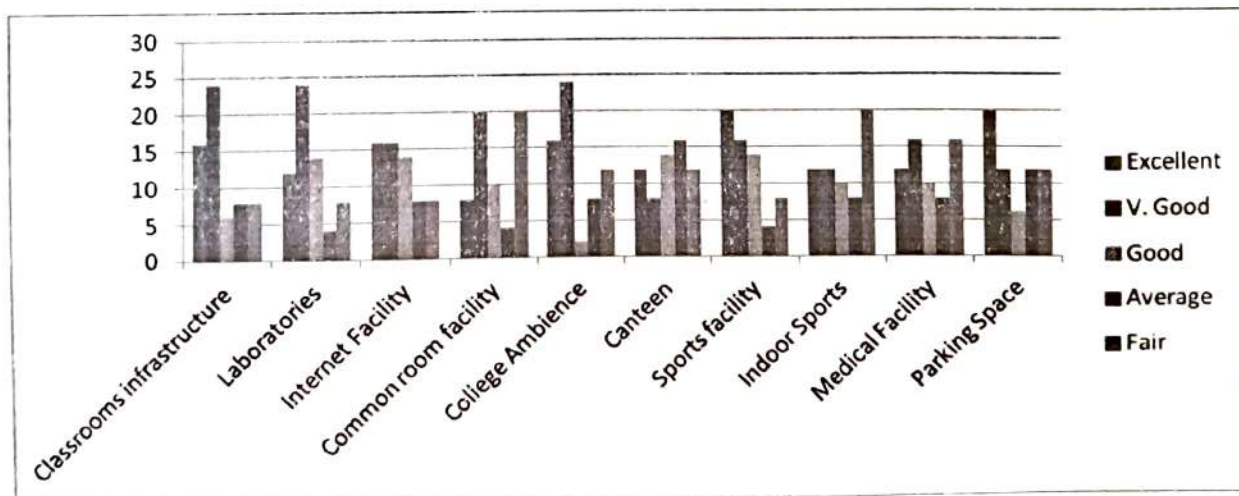

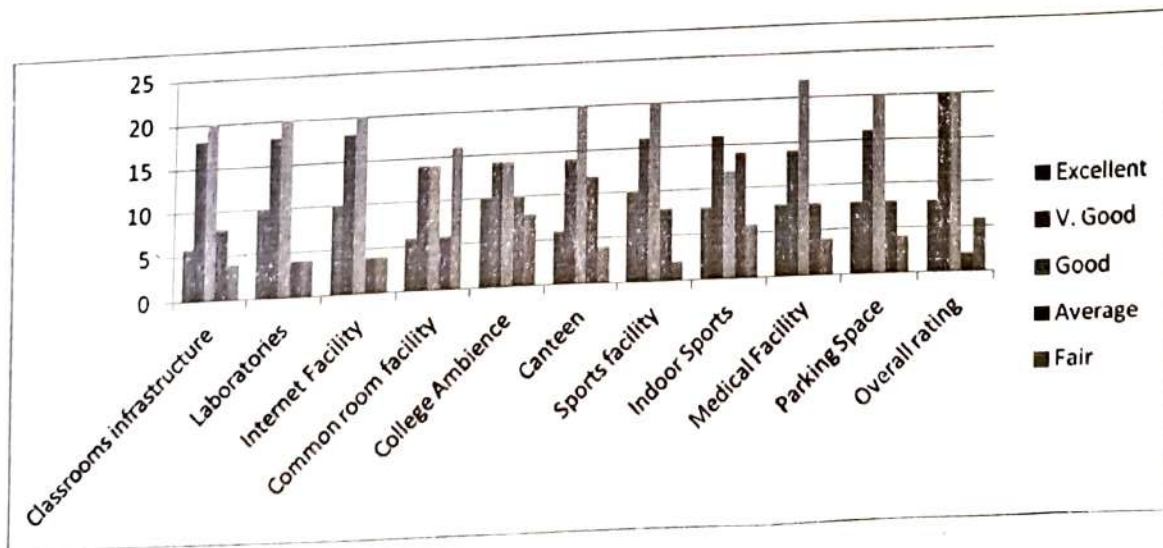

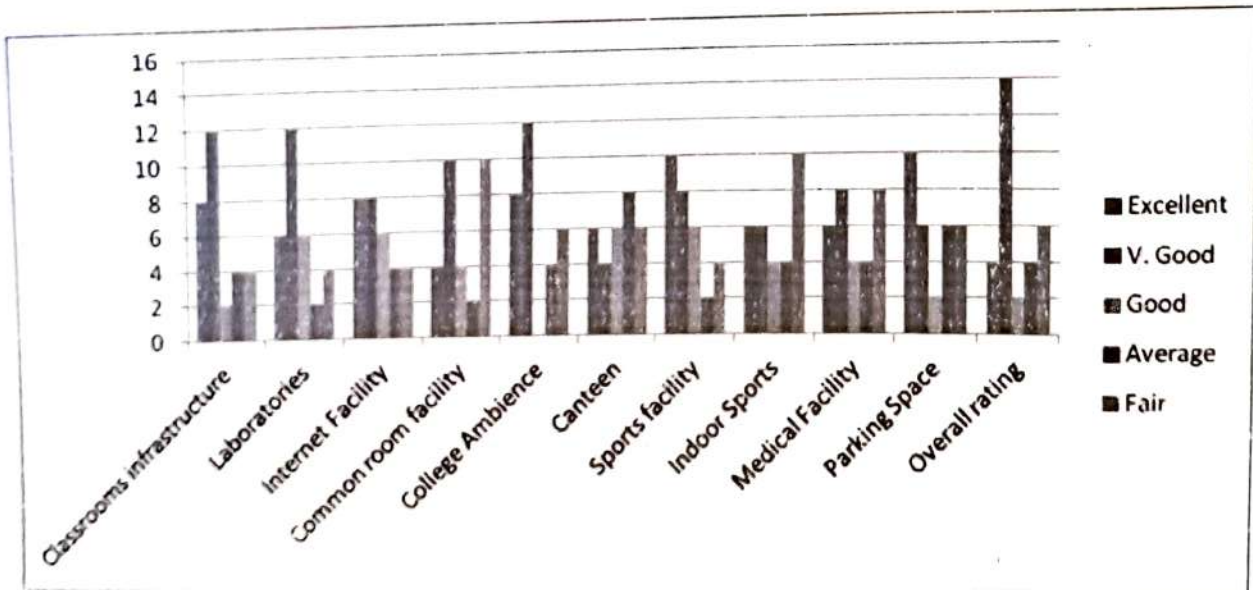
